Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to clarify the purpose of KS4 study hall and the system that we have in place for this to run.

As you are aware, in order to make school as safe as possible with regard to COVID, we staggered the start times for KS3 and KS4 with KS4 starting at 10am. We are aware that some students do not have a quiet place to study at home or that some students work better away from home within the school building. To support these students, we took the decision to allow Year 11s in to study from 9:05am to 9:55am in the Conservatory and for Year 10s to do the same in the Canteen. Students do not have direct teacher input during this time. The purpose is to provide them with the space for independent learning.

As from tomorrow, entrance (via the Padua gate) to the study area will close at 9:05am and a register will be taken at 9:10am. If your son/daughter arrives after 9:05am they will not be allowed entry. They **must not** enter through reception. This register will be used for emergency purposes. If you would like to confirm that your son/daughter is in attendance, please contact school and they will check this register.

I hope the above clarifies any queries you may have had about the running of this system.
