Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that all students will finish early on Monday to enable preparations for Open Evening to be completed. Students will leave at approximately 12:30pm. Food will be available at breaktime, but not lunchtime, although those on free school meals can order a packed lunch to take away with them.

We are seeing a steady number of positive results for COVID across all year groups, both with home tests and with PCRs. We are still awaiting delivery of further home tests and these will be distributed once they arrive in school. The government has advised that students continue to LFT test at home twice a week; we suggest Sunday and Wednesday evening.

**Steps to take if the LFT result is positive**

1. Log it on the NHS Track and Test site using this link: [www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result](https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result)
2. Book a PCR test and inform school via email or phone of the result

Students who have tested positive on the PCR will need to self-isolate 10 days. Students who are a close contact will also need to go for a PCR but can continue to come into school unless they have symptoms.

As you will be aware from the media, the government have now approved COVID immunisation for 12-15 year olds. Accompanying this letter are relevant NHS leaflets and the required consent form. If you wish your child to be immunised, please complete and return the consent form.
