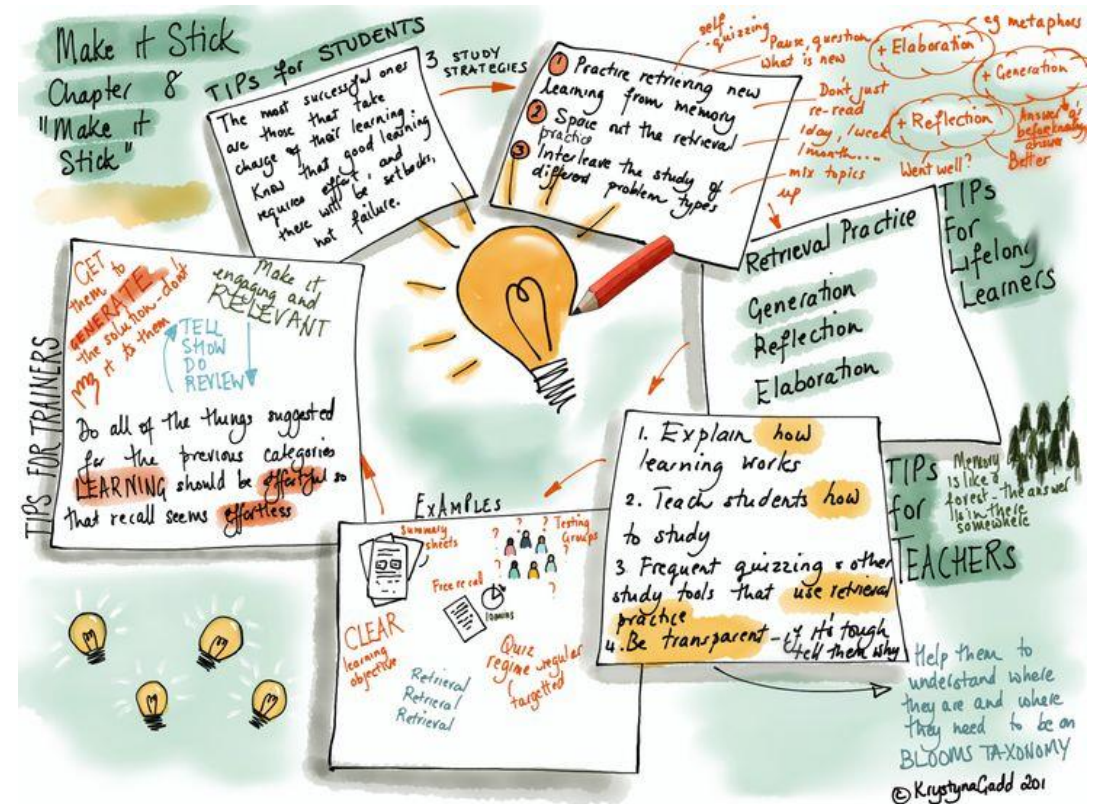

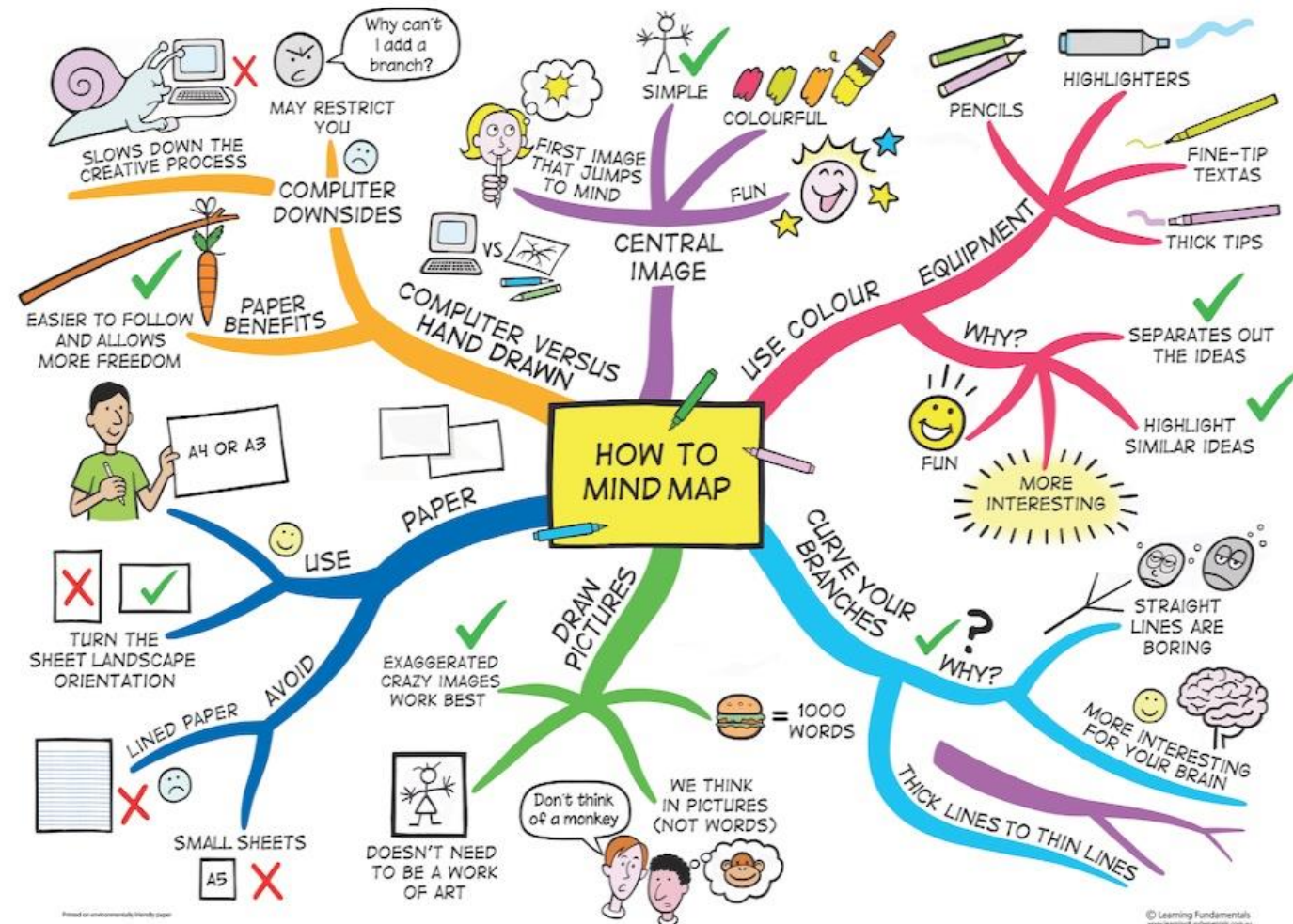
Retrieval Practice

Retrieval Practice: Mind Maps

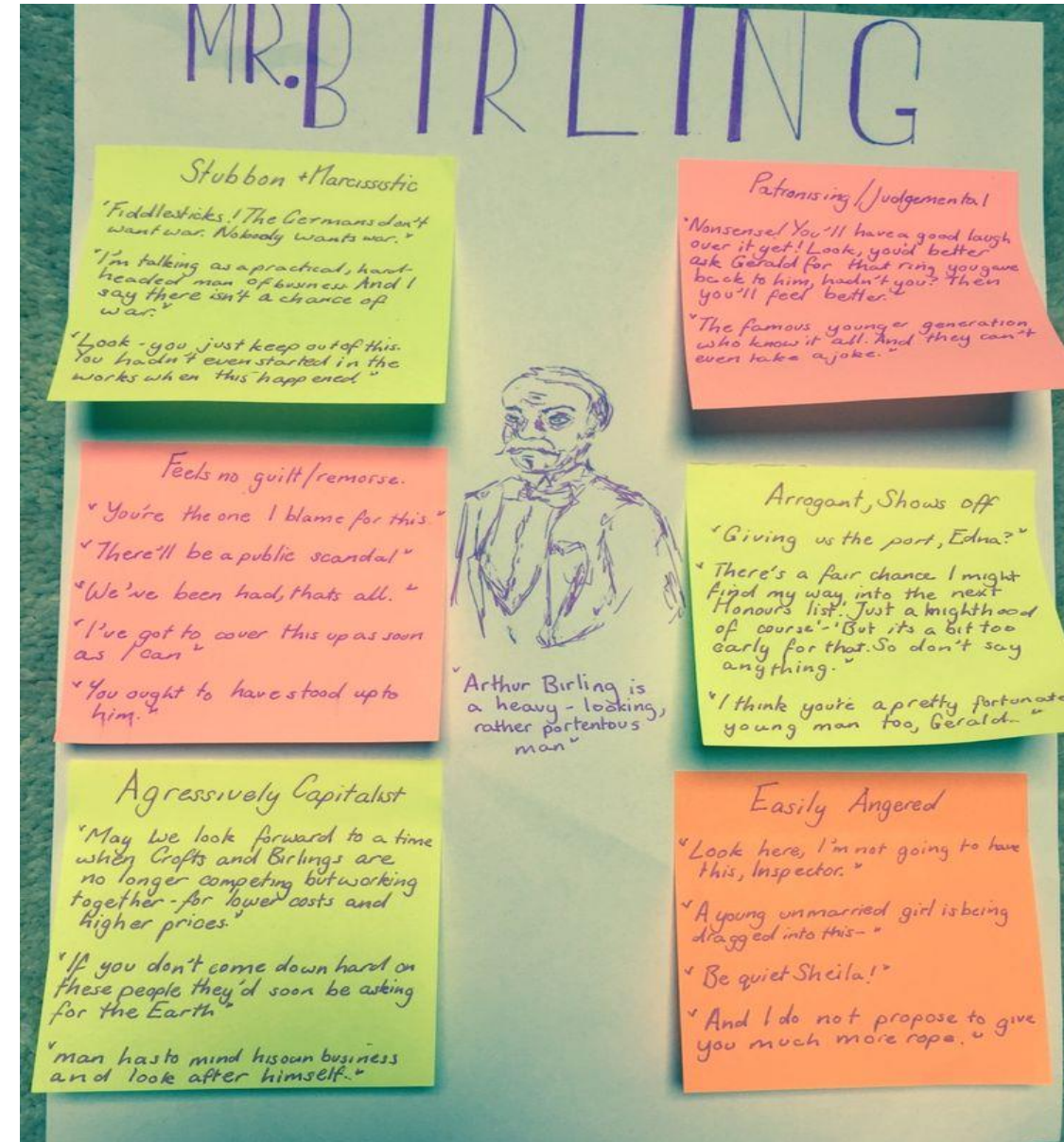
- Key question, exam question or a key topic in the centre
- Subtopics or subheadings
- Add key pieces of information
- Develop some of your points
- Add symbols or images – Dual coding for maximum impact
- Use different coloured pens or highlight different points
- Use different sized pieces of paper.

- Definitions/sub topics
- Bullet point the answer to key questions
- Different post it notes, each containing different parts of an answer to one question
- Can be moved around, linked or prioritised.
