Welcome from our Chair of Governors

St Antony's is a wonderful school. The atmosphere is warm and welcoming. The staff body, both support and teaching, make a great team. The students are fabulous; well behaved and keen to learn.

I have been involved with St Antony's since 2013 when I joined the school as a Foundation Governor taking on the role of Chair of Governors in 2018. 

Directions from the North

- Leave the M60 at J9 (Intu Trafford Centre South)
- Take the second exit from the roundabout onto Barton Road (BP Garage then shops on left)
- Take the first right turn onto Moss Vale Road (runs alongside and below M60)
- Turn right at the first mini-roundabout (Junction with Winchester Road) taking you under the M60
- Turn left at the second mini-roundabout onto Moss Vale Road (alongside and below M60).
- Take the first left onto Bradfield Road (back under the M60).
- St Antony's is on the left hand side.
- If there are no parking spaces in the main car-park, please try the side car-park taking the second entrance into the school.

Directions from the South

- Exit the M60 at J9 (Intu Trafford Centre)
- Stay in the left hand lane
- Turn left onto Barton Road
- Take the very next immediate left onto Canterbury Road
- Take the third left onto Wallingford Road, follow this road round until it meets
- Winchester Road. Turn left (immediately onto the mini-roundabout) and turn right on the roundabout onto Moss Vale Road (keeping the motorway on your left hand side)
- Follow Moss Vale Road over the railway bridge and take the first left under the motorway onto Bradfield Road
- St Antony's is on the left hand side.
- If there are no parking spaces in the main car-park, please try the side car-park taking the second entrance into the school.
