Dear Parent/Carer,

In line with the Government's Covid-19 Recovery Plan, all schools have been allocated funding with which they are expected to put in place catch-up tuition in key core subjects. At St Antony's we have deemed this to include Maths and English, due to their importance in allowing students to move on to their next educational steps, and Science as this will contribute to two of each child's GCSEs when they reach that point in their studies.

Your child has been identified by one of these subject areas as being someone who would benefit from the tuition packages that we have been able to put in place for them. Children will receive this tuition from a qualified and experienced tutor in a small group.

In order for these sessions to be possible within the school day it is unavoidable that students will have to be taken out of other subjects. In creating the timetable for your child's sessions I have tried to spread these lessons so that no subject is affected more than any other whilst also avoiding these core lessons. Students are often reluctant to miss the lessons that are affected and I hope that you will join me in stressing that it is so important that they make the most of this fantastic opportunity and highlight to them that it is only for seven and a half weeks. I will remind students that the school's usual behaviour policy applies regarding these tuition lessons.
