Subject: Rewards system

Dear parent / carer,

We have introduced a new rewards system in school this year to recognise and celebrate students making positive choices and working hard. Students can be awarded achievement points by their form tutors, subject teachers and Learning Support Assistants. 63,632 achievement points have been awarded so far, that's an average of 93 per student. Currently, achievement points are awarded for positive behaviours such as:

- Excellent effort throughout a lesson
- Attending extra-curricular activities
- Reading 5 books
- Excellent test/assessment result
- Improvement in test/assessment score
- Excellent homework
- Helping others/being a good role model
- Dr Frost top 10
- Speaking French confidently

Weekly subject award badges are also issued to recognise those who consistently go above and beyond or those who have made a significant improvement in that subject.

At the end of each half-term, we hold a rewards assembly for each year group. During the rewards assemblies, students are issued with badges, certificates and additional prizes based on their accumulated achievement points.

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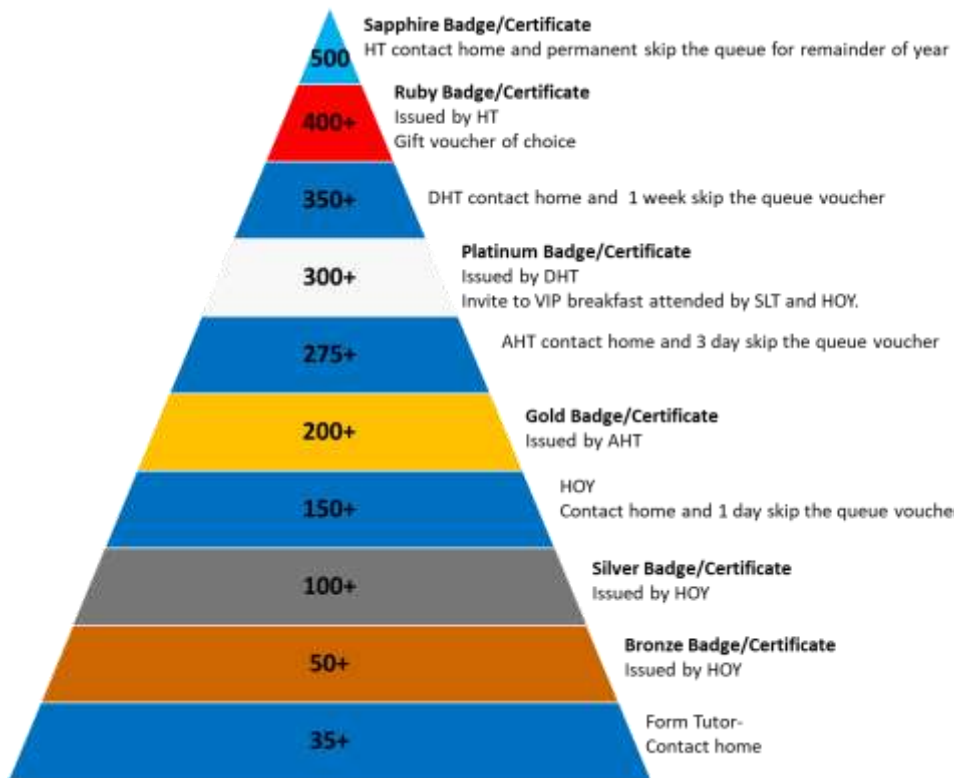
