I am happy to inform you that we are arranging a much deserved residential trip for the year 10s. We have a booking at **PGL Winmarleigh Hall** for Monday 18<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> of March 2024. The centre is specifically designed to cater for large numbers of students. The course we have booked offers many activities, including zip lines; archery; jacob's ladder; raft building and many others. The centre employs fully-trained staff for each activity and risk assessments for each activity are available from school. I should also point out that once the places have been booked, the school will be required to pay the full cost of the weekend, so cancellation by yourselves will have a severe impact on a fund, which can be used for other purposes and to the benefit of other students in the school.

To ensure this is a positive experience for all, understandably, we will have high expectations of behavior in the lead up to this trip. I do hope your child will be able to join us. I feel it to be a most worthwhile venture, which will remain with him/her for a long time to come.
