Foundation Governors are appointed by the Bishop to represent his education policy and contribute to the creation of 'Strong Trusts and Great schools'

Who can be a Foundation Governor?

- You must be over 18
- A practising Catholic, not a requirement if you want to be considered for a non-Foundation role
- A diverse range of skills

Time commitment:

10 to 12 hours per term involving attending actual and virtual meetings and training events

Those already involved in governance at school or trust level find the role particularly rewarding evidenced by the fact that so many chose to remain in post beyond the end of the normal four year term of office.

There is no magic formula about what makes a perfect Governor - they come from all walks of life and all ages with a mix of skills, knowledge and experience. The ability to analyse presented information, challenge thinking and identify good solutions to complex issues or thorny issues.

















HOW TO FIND OUT MORE

The Diocese of Salford provided Catholic Academy Trusts, schools and colleges for the following reasons;
