3rd Sunday of Advent - GAUDETE - 15th December 2024



Dear Parishioners,

Today we, here in Urmston, Davyhulme and Flixton, continue a great Roman tradition that is celebrated every Gaudete Sunday. We bless the bambino Gesu, and send him from the Church to make His home in ours, and in doing so we remind ourselves that Jesus is the only reason for this festive season! This is reiterated throughout the week as we ponder what is called the "O Anti-

phons" (its where the

hymn O Come, O Come Emmanuel finds its orgin). Another great and ancient Advent tradition, where as we enter the final days of this season our anticipation is heighten as the birth of the Saviour draws nearer.

Each O Antiphon emphasises a unique prophetic title of the soon-to-be-born King of Kings, the bambino that comes home with us, as foreshadowed in the Old Testament by the prophet Isaiah, which we have been reading through Mass over the last few weeks: Wisdom, Lord of Israel, Root of Jes-

se, Key of David, Radiant Dawn, King of All Nations, and Emmanuel.


I am always fascinated by the fact that if you take the first letter of each antiphon (in the Latin) and read them from last to first, the word ERO CRAS is spelt, which translates:

"Tomorrow I will come."

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

If you live in Trafford and your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021, they are eligible to start school from 1 September 2025. You must apply to Trafford for all your preferred schools, including schools in other local authority areas. The closing date for primary school applications is 15 January 2025.

For Catholic Schools copies of Baptism Certificates will be requested. Please see Fr. K after Sunday Mass to request copies of certificates.

THE SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION EUCHARIST & CONFIRMATION

EUCHARIST (HOLY COMMUNION)

The Eucharist is the source and summit of all Christian life, the Eucharist is not a thing or a

holy object, the Eucharist is the gift of God Himself given and shared with us.

All parent's of children who will be entering Yr 3 (in September 2024) will be invited from the beginning of May 2024 to enrol their children on the Sacramental Programme. All children must be baptised in the Catholic Church and families **WILL** be expected, to do what all Catholic families should already be doing, that is attend Sunday Mass.



CONFIRMATION All details will be published in the newsletter and a notice will be sent to our local Diocesan Catholic Secondary School (St. Antony's) and those schools that are in the Diocese of Shrewsbury (BTH, St. Ambrose & Loreto). Registering an interest is **not** joining the pro-

gramme, and as the child enters Yr8 (Sept 2024) they will have to make the commitment to participate on the programme and complete the sacraments of initiation. Please not that although information is sent to High Schools outside the Diocese of Salford and the non-Catholic schools in the area, distribution of information is dependent upon the cooperation of the Head teacher and Head of RE.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The Code of Canon Law states:
"Parents are obliged to see to it that infants are baptised
within the first weeks after birth"

As a Parish, we follow the Diocesan Baptism Policy

In order for your baby/child (under the age of 7) to be baptised, if you are not already practising your Catholic faith, then you must begin to **attend Sunday Mass for a minimum of at least 6 weeks** before a baptism date can be discussed.

- ♦ If you live outside the Parish, but this Parish is your place of regular worship, no permission is needed.
- If you live outside the Parish and don't regularly attend Mass, permission from your Parish Priest is needed.
- ◆ After a date for baptism has been set, a meeting with Fr. Kieren or Deacon John must be arranged (by you).
- ♦ If your child is over 7 they must be treated as an adult and must follow an adapted RCIA programme.
