Dear Parents and Carers

This is a short letter to wish you all well for the Easter period and to thank you for your ongoing support.

Pupils and staff are very much ready for the break after a busy Spring term. I continue to be proud of our achievements as a school and how much we are all growing as individuals and collectively. More than ever, we are seeing your children blossom into the best version of themselves.

Finally, after the Easter break, we will be paying close attention to uniform standards of all pupils – so please support us to avoid conflict with your child by ensuring your child has all the correct uniform and equipment that we expect. This includes wearing appropriate footwear.
