St Antony's is committed to ensuring that all pupils, staff, parents and visitors can access our school environment, curriculum and information in line with the Equality Act 2010. We proactively identify and remove barriers so that disabled pupils are not placed at a substantial disadvantage.

Our approach aligns with the three statutory strands of the Act:

1. Increasing access to the curriculum

We are committed to ensuring high-quality, adaptive teaching so that all pupils, including those with SEND, can participate fully in learning. Staff receive ongoing training to strengthen inclusive practice, and we continue to develop the effective use of assistive technologies and supportive resources. We work closely with parents, carers and professionals to ensure provision remains responsive to pupil needs. Additionally, at St Antony's we will continue to build a community that celebrates the achievement of all, at all levels. School leaders are committed to providing further resources to ensure increasing numbers of pupils are recognised for living out of values each day.

2. Improving the physical environment

We aim to maintain and develop a school environment that is safe, accessible and welcoming to all. This includes improving physical access where required, enhancing navigation and signage around the site, and ensuring appropriate spaces are available to support pupils who may need a quieter or more regulated environment. Adjustments are planned with both current and future pupils in mind.

3. Improving access to information

We are committed to ensuring that information is accessible to all members of our community. Where needed, information can be provided in alternative formats, and we continue to improve the clarity, inclusivity and accessibility of our written and digital communications.

Ongoing Review

Our Accessibility Plan is reviewed annually by senior leaders and governors to ensure progress continues and actions remain aligned with pupil needs and our Trust-wide SEND policy. We remain committed to fostering a culture of respect, inclusivity and belonging across the school.
