Artist, landscape artist of the year, and ex-pupil of St Antony's demonstrates to you how to use 1 point perspective.

Do (These are tricky tasks that will take time and practise!)

- 1.) Complete the activities and attempt your own 1 point perspective drawings (I recommend trying at least 3). To make it easier, start with a simpler image with less detail, such as a traffic light / phone box or a photograph of your house and gradually use more complicated reference images.
- 2.) Create a double page Artist study of Manchester-based Michelle Taube. Taube uses mixed media such as paint and collage to create her vibrant images of streets and buildings. She often uses lots of patterns. Use this as inspiration along with your knowledge of perspective to create your double page. You DO NOT have to copy one of her pieces, you can instead create your own inspired by her work. Try to use your own photos for reference.
