After creating your own poem about the area that you live answer the following question. Is it a negative poem or a positive one? Why do you think you have written in that way?

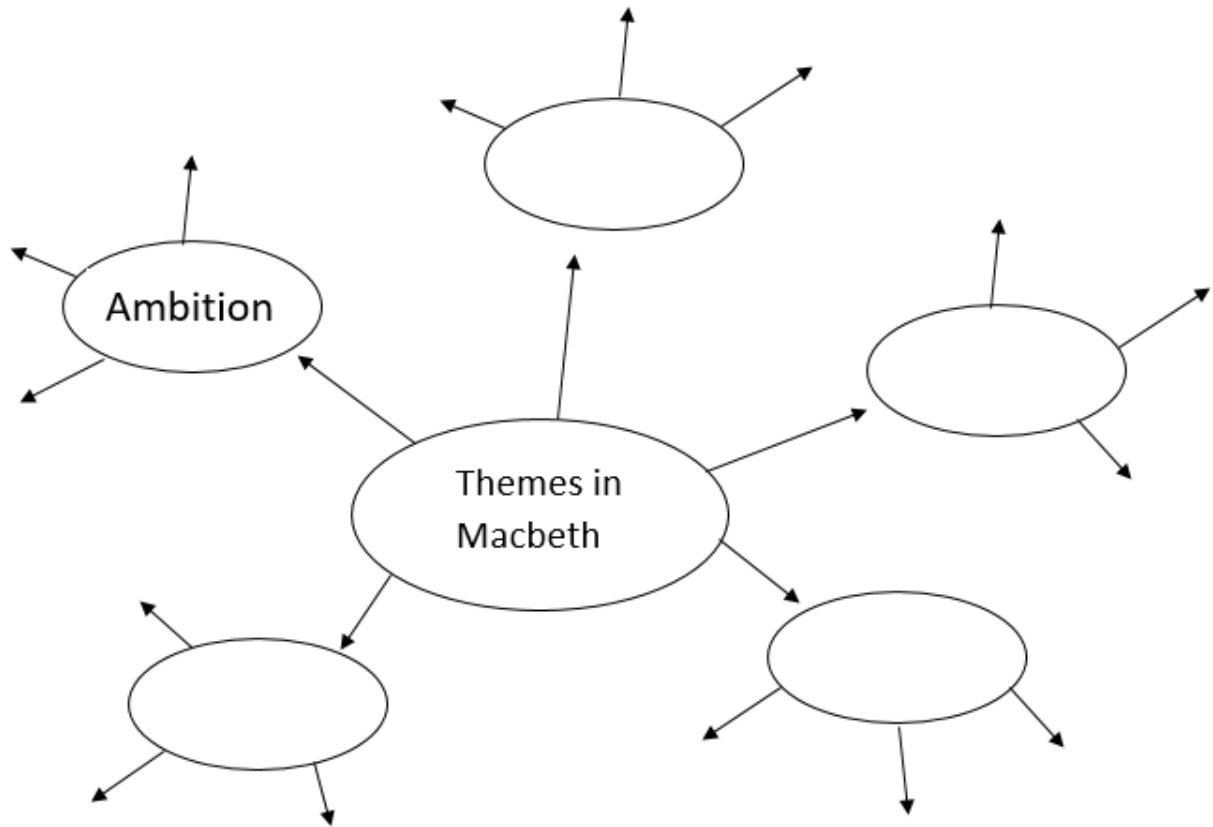
