


Following on from our work on persecution in Nazi Germany we are going to investigate the life of Anne Frank in more detail. Anne lived in the Netherlands with her family. Her father Otto owned a business. Seeing that the situation in the Netherlands was becoming worse for Jews after the Nazis invaded, he decided to place the family in hiding in the annexe of his business. Anne was 13 years old when she went into hiding and she remained there from 1942 to 1944 when the family were discovered and sent to concentration camps. During her time in the annexe, Anne wrote diaries detailing her life there. The diaries were published after the war and became world famous.

This week we will be using a virtual tour on the secret annexe to investigate Anne Frank's life during her time in hiding.
