# WORKSHEET TWO: The Prodigal Son

Normally, people gain their inheritance when a parent dies. The Son had obviously decided that he couldn't wait that long!

There were no transport systems at the time of Jesus and there were many wild animals.

People rarely went on long journeys.

The son had clearly decided that he was going to make a new life for himself and that he wasn't coming back.

The son obviously squandered his money and hit 'rock bottom'. Jewish people regard pigs as dirty animals, so to be desperate to eat the pig's food means he was in a very bad situation.

The elder son does not approve of the younger son and all that he did. It doesn't stop at disapproval; the elder son does not ACCEPT his little brother!

The father does not approve of his younger son's behaviour, but he does accept his son unconditionally for who he really is. In his heart, the father still loves his son.

The father offers his repentant son UNCONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE

this is what God always offers each of us. This is what St. John means when he says GOD IS LOVE
