5: Read through the Bible teachings on worksheet four and complete the tasks.

WORK SHEET ONE: Could you forgive?

Read the scenario's below and explain if you would be able to forgive these actions. Give at least one reason for your decision

Scenario	Could you forgive? Respond in full sentences <i>I could/could not forgive this because...</i>
You just found out that your best friend has been telling everyone your deepest secret	
You were playing a board game and lost your temper because you thought someone was cheating.	
You are in the school yard and your "Friend" keeps picking on you "Jokingly "in front of everyone. While it's upsetting you, they apologize.	
Everyone in class got invited to a party but you didn't get an invitation.	

WORKSHEET TWO: The case of Antony Walker

Watch the short documentary about Antony Walker

- 1) Explain using 150 words what happened to Antony and why
- 2) Explain how Antony's family responded to the people who killed Antony
- 3) How would you feel if this happen within your family? Do you think you could forgive like Mrs Walker?
- 4) If you could ask Mrs Walker a question what would it be?
- 5) Do you think the Walker's attitude reflect society's attitudes to forgiveness?

Extension Activity

Research the case of Lee Rigby and answer to following questions

1. Do you think we should forgive the murderers for what they did? Why/why not?
2. How do you think Muslims should respond to the attacks?
 1. How would a Christian respond to the violent actions of the murderers? Include a religious teaching in your answer.

Read these teachings and **explain** how it might influence a Christian's view of forgiveness **today**.

Teaching	Meaning for Christians
'If someone hits you on the right cheek, turn and offer them your left as well.' (Matthew 5:39)	
"Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times?" ²² Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times." (Matthew 18:21-22)	
⁴ Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. ^a And lead us not into temptation. ^b " (Luke 11:4) Read full chapter	
¹² And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. Read full chapter
